ON THE ROAD..

As you may know, we have local police on site periodically to help us manage some of the traffic issues at Spanish Wells. Their focus is on two things: maintaining the 25 mph speed limit and enforcing the Stop signs.

In the past few weeks, citations have been written, to residents and non-residents who have not observed the rules of the road. Even golf carts which do not stop at the Stop signs can be cited!

Also, with a newly passed Florida law as of July 1, 2023 teens will not be able to drive golf carts without a permit or driver's license.
